Conditions of Entry (The Rules) :-

- Stall holders need to be available for the 2 days
- **The fair opening times to the Public are Saturday 9am to 4pm & Sunday 9am to 3pm**
- The organisers are not responsible for any theft or breakages.
- The venue will be open Friday afternoon at 1pm for stall holders to set up their tables if desired. The set up on Friday will close at 6.00pm.
- The venue will open Saturday Morning at 7am for stall holders to set up their tables before 9.00am
- Stall holders are responsible for their items during the Fair. Entry, set up and removal of items at the fair is at the Stall Holders own risk. Stall holders are to arrange their own stall holders public liability insurance.
- Stall holders are to ensure their tables have appropriate cloths/table drapes to the floor to hide extra stock out of public view.
- There is to be NO stock in-front of tables on floor area. This is to maintain public safety.
- Identification name tags are to be worn at all times during the event
- Parking for stall holder vehicles is at the rear of the venue
- Stall holders are responsible for their own rubbish and excess boxes at the end of the fair. No rubbish is to be left at the venue.
- Packing up and removal of items from Fair venue is to be restricted until close of the event at 3pm on the Sunday. Packing up is to be completed by 5.30pm
- Should a seller wish to only sell on a Saturday, please contact CBCC Secretary Cheryl to discuss this option.
- The Cannington Exhibition Centre is a non-smoking hall.
- Public will be charged an entry fee of \$2

Note: Club facilities and refreshments for drinks, food and snacks will be available from 9.00am when venue opens to public. Tea & Coffee will be available to stall holders (please bring your own cup).
